ABOUT THE ROLE

- High demand for: ASL, Amharic, Cantonese, Mandarin, Russian, Spanish, Tigrinya,
 Ukrainian & Vietnamese. Other languages also needed.
- Must be fluent in the language.
- Do not need to be medically certified.
- Job aid provided with commonly used clinical terms and phrases.
- A virtual medically certified interpretation system is available if further interpretation support is needed.
- Interpreters do not stay with a patient for the duration of the clinic but instead help various patients in a designated location.
- Do not sign up to volunteer on days when you're accompanying a friend or family member.








- 750+ Patients Per Day

- Dental services: Hygiene, restorative, extractions, select endodontics,
 CEREC crowns, temporary partials (flippers), radiographs.
- Vision services: Complete dilated eye exams, glaucoma screening, diabetic retinopathy, readers, prescription eyeglasses.
- All patients are triaged and have their blood pressure, temperature, and medical history taken before being seen in care areas.
- Volunteer for as many days as you desire. Full shift participation is important to maintain operational efficiency. Shift start and end times are indicated next to each assignment in the registration system.
- Masks are optional for all participants but are strongly encouraged in crowded areas and may be required during some treatment processes. This policy may change according to public health guidance and community metrics for respiratory viruses.
- Volunteers must be at least 18 years of age.
- Approved mission of the Public Health Reserve Corps (Seattle & King County).
- Other general support roles include:
 - Patient Registration & Records
 - Patient Escorts & Waiting Areas
 - Early AM Patient Line
 - Administrative, IT & Operations Support
