

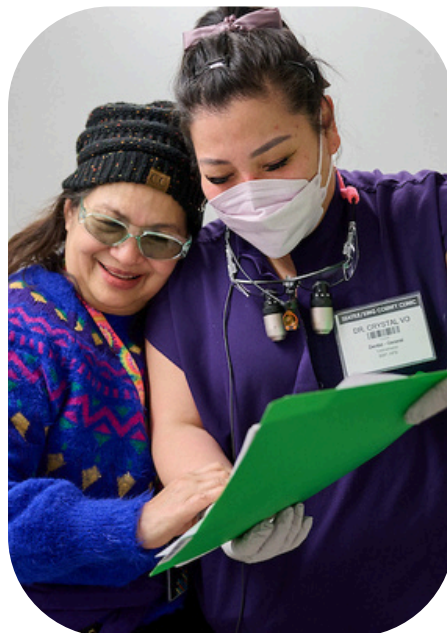

THE FINE PRINT

- Vision services: complete dilated eye exams, glaucoma screening, diabetic retinopathy, readers, prescription eyeglasses.
- Volunteer for as many days as you desire. **Full shift participation** is important to maintain operational efficiency. Shift start and end times are indicated next to each assignment in the registration system.
- Healthcare professionals must be licensed/credentialed in the U.S. to volunteer in a clinical capacity. Out-of-state professionals **MUST** submit an attestation form to the WA State Department of Health to volunteer.
- **Licensed healthcare professionals are responsible for securing professional liability insurance.** They may be able to receive free malpractice insurance through the state-sponsored Volunteer and Retired Providers Program.
- Healthcare residents are welcome.
- Limited space available for students currently enrolled in a clinical program.
- Volunteers also needed for Eyeglasses Dispensing May 30 – 31.
