- Healthcare professionals must be licensed/credentialed in the U.S. to volunteer in a clinical capacity. Out-of-state professionals MUST submit an attestation form to the WA State Department of Health to volunteer.
- Licensed healthcare professionals are responsible for securing professional liability insurance. They may be able to receive free malpractice insurance through the statesponsored Volunteer and Retired Providers Program.
- Healthcare residents are welcome.
- Limited space available for students currently enrolled in a clinical program.
