UNDERSTANDING FEES AT COMMUNITY HEALTH CENTERS (CHCs):

- CHCs provide quality healthcare to anyone, whatever their circumstances.
- If you are unable to pay you can still receive care, you will not be turned away.
- CHCs can help you determine what health insurance and other programs you may qualify for and help you apply.
- CHCs also offer "sliding scale" discounted fees. Discounts are based on your income and family size.
- You will be asked to provide proof of your income.
- The CHC will work with you on a payment plan you can afford.
